We are currently seeking a Head Diving Coach (m/f/d) as of 01.01.2024

The part-time position (30 hours/week) is initially limited to two years, with an option for extension.

Your main tasks include:

- Overall responsibility for diving performance for GAK athletes
- Responsible realization of the daily training process for assigned squads with the aim of successful participation in national/international championships training and competition planning, conditioning, technique training, mental preparation
- Supervising, supporting recreational and health sport squads/groups
- Setup of goals and training process for professional- and recreational/health athletes
- Development and leadership of the GAK coaching staff, as well as structuring a competition program in close coordination with all coaches.
- Implementation of individual training plans and ensuring training data documentation, as well as conducting regular comprehensive performance diagnostics.
- Supporting the federal and state squad athletes of the base groups at competitions and championships at regional, national and international levels
- Participation in performance promotion measures within the framework of the State Performance Center (LLZ) in Graz and the Austrian Swimming Federation (OSV) annual planning: training camps, courses, sports medical examinations, performance diagnostics in collaboration with the superior National Coach.
- Participation in coach education and further training, as well as other training measures, also in coordination with the LLZ and/or the National Coach.
- Secondary responsibilities may include recruiting, scouting
